



# 2019 RMDC ATTENDEE POLICIES

## MDDS Member Registration Policies

- To attend the 2019 RMDC free of charge, MDDS members must pay their 2098 membership dues in full by **December 31, 2018**.
- If full payment of 2019 membership dues cannot be verified by **December 31, 2018**, the registration category will be changed to "Non-ADA Member" and the credit card on file will be charged \$695. A notification email will be sent if this charge is applied.
- If full payment of 2019 membership dues is received by **March 31, 2019**, the Non-ADA Member fee of \$695 will be **reimbursed in full**. If full payment is not received by this deadline, there will be **no reimbursement** even if dues are paid in full at a later date. There will be no exception to this policy.

## Convention Cancellation Policy

Cancellations for both registration and fee courses/events will be accepted and are entitled to a refund provided they are sent in writing to MDDS at 925 Lincoln St., Unit B, Denver, CO 80203 and postmarked by **December 31, 2018**. A \$25.00 administrative fee will be deducted from the refund for each cancelled registration.

No refunds of any kind will be given for cancellations postmarked after December 31, 2018.

## Mailing of Badges/Course Tickets

Convention badges and course tickets will be mailed to all attendees registered by December 8, 2018. Attendees registered after this deadline, will need to pick up their badges and tickets onsite at Registration in Lobby "D" at the Colorado Convention Center.

## Course Ticket Policy

All courses at the 2019 RMDC will be ticketed. If you did not select your courses during the online registration process, you can access your registration at a later date via the Registrant Services Center link at [rmdconline.com](http://rmdconline.com). You will need the login and password from your registration confirmation.

Tickets will be mailed with the attendee's name badge as long as the registration has been submitted by December 7, 2018. For all registrations received after this deadline, the attendee will need to pick up their course tickets along with their name badge onsite at Registration in Lobby "D" at the Colorado Convention Center.

Tickets will be collected at each meeting room. No admittance to any course will be permitted without a ticket.

## Substitution Policy

Substitutions are allowed. To make a substitution you will need to call MDDS Registration Services at (303) 488-9700 to change the registrant's information and pay any difference in fee.

Unless otherwise noted, one clock hour equals one credit hour. Continuing education courses may not apply toward license renewal/CE requirements in all states. It is the responsibility of each attendee to verify the requirements of his/her licensing board or the organization to which he/she must submit proof of continuing education. Please check with your state board or other applicable organization if you have questions.

### **Receiving Verification of Attendance**

All attendees who require proof of attendance for CE credits must collect the CE code that is read at the end of the course.

Following the convention, attendees may log on to [rmdconline.com](http://rmdconline.com) to print a CE verification document for each course they attended. CE verification documents will not print unless the attendee enters the correct CE code.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** CE codes will be read at the end of each course and will not be given to attendees at any other time during or following the convention. Please collect and keep the CE code for each class you attend, whether you think you will need it or not.
