



## 2021 RMDC *Anywhere* Attendee Policies

### MDDS Member Registration Policies

- To attend RMDC *Anywhere* free of charge, MDDS members must pay their 2021 membership dues in full by **December 31, 2020**.
- If full payment of 2021 membership dues cannot be verified by **December 31, 2020**, the registration category will be changed to “Non-ADA Member” and the credit card on file will be charged \$695. A notification email will be sent if this charge is applied.
- If full payment of 2021 membership dues is received by **March 31, 2021**, the Non-ADA Member fee of \$695 will be **reimbursed in full**. If full payment is not received by this deadline, there will be **no reimbursement** even if dues are paid in full at a later date. There will be no exception to this policy.

### Convention Cancellation Policy

Cancellations for both registration and fee events will be accepted and are entitled to a refund provided they are sent in writing to MDDS at [finance@mddsdentist.com](mailto:finance@mddsdentist.com) or 925 Lincoln St., Unit B, Denver, CO 80203 and postmarked by **December 31, 2020**. A \$25.00 administrative fee will be deducted from the refund for each cancelled registration.

No refunds of any kind will be given for cancellations postmarked after December 31, 2020.

### **Receiving Verification of Attendance**

All attendees who require proof of attendance for CE credits must collect the CE code that is listed and/or read at the end of the course.

During the convention, attendees may go to the Attendee Lounge to enter the code and print a CE verification document for each course they attend.

Following the convention, attendees can login to the Registrant Services Center at [rmdonline.com](http://rmdonline.com) to enter the code and print a CE verification document.

CE verification documents will not print unless the attendee enters the correct CE code.

IMPORTANT NOTE: CE codes will be listed and/or read at the end of each course and will not be given to attendees at any other time during or following the convention. Please collect and keep the CE code for each class you attend, whether you think you will need it or not.
