



2023 RMDC ATTENDEE POLICIES

RMDC Health and Safety Information

The 2023 Rocky Mountain Dental Convention (RMDC) will monitor developments surrounding COVID-19. The safety and well-being of our exhibitors, attendees, partners and team is our number one priority. RMDC 2023 will be conducted in accordance with federal, state and local safety guidelines and protocols. We will communicate all such guidelines and protocols to registered attendees as they become available.

MDDS Member Registration Policies

- To attend the 2023 RMDC free of charge, MDDS members must pay their 2023 membership dues in full by **December 31, 2022** or be enrolled in a payment plan.
- If full payment of 2023 membership dues or enrollment in a payment plan cannot be verified by **December 31, 2022**, the registration category will be changed to “Non-ADA Member” and the credit card on file will be charged \$725. A notification email will be sent if this charge is applied.
- If full payment of 2023 membership dues is received or the dentist is enrolled in a payment plan by **March 31, 2023**, the Non-ADA Member fee of \$725 will be **reimbursed in full**. If full payment is not received or dentist is not enrolled in a payment plan by this deadline, there will be **no reimbursement**, even if dues are paid in full at a later date. There will be no exceptions to this policy.

Convention Cancellation Policy

Cancellations for both registration and fee courses will be accepted and are entitled to a refund provided they are sent in writing to MDDS at finance@mddsdentist.com by December 31, 2022. A \$25 administrative fee will be deducted from the refund for each cancelled registration.

If a name badge has been mailed prior to request for cancellation, the refund will not be processed until the badge has been returned to MDDS at 925 Lincoln St., Unit B, Denver, CO 80203.

Mailing of Badges/Course Tickets

Convention badges and course tickets for in-person participation at the Colorado Convention Center will be mailed to all attendees who have registered by November 29, 2022. Attendees registered after this deadline will need to pick up their badges and tickets onsite at Registration in Lobby “D” of the Colorado Convention Center.

Name Badge Corrections

To make a correction to your registration, please access your original registration via the Registrant Services Center link at rmdconline.com. You will need the login and password from your registration confirmation.

Substitution Policy

Substitutions are allowed. To make a substitution call MDDS Registration Services at (303) 488-9700 to change the registrant's information and pay any difference in fee.

Continuing Education Credits

Unless otherwise noted, one clock hour equals one credit hour. Continuing education courses may not apply toward license renewal/CE requirements in all states. It is the responsibility of each attendee to verify the requirements of his/her licensing board or the organization to which he/she must submit proof of continuing education. Please check with your state board or other applicable organization if you have questions.

Receiving Verification of Attendance

All attendees who require proof of attendance for CE credits must collect the CE code that is read at the end of the course.

Following the convention, attendees may log on to rmdconline.com to print a CE verification document for each course they attended. CE verification documents will not print unless the attendee enters the correct CE code.

IMPORTANT NOTE: CE codes will be read at the end of each course and will not be given to attendees at any other time during or following the convention. Please collect and keep the CE code for each class you attend, whether you think you will need it or not.
